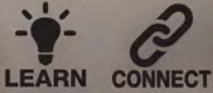

The Life-Changing Impact of Backpacks

Last year, Jose Juan and Jorge's family came to the drive-thru City Kids event. This year, they're looking forward to being able to attend in person and take advantage of all the booths, which include haircuts, dental booth, crafts, hot food, family photos and more!

Jose Juan just turned 10 last month. For the last two years, both he and his brother, Jorge, who is 7, have received backpacks through the Mission's City Kids events.

"I liked the color," Jose Juan says, referring to his backpack from last year. *"It was blue and orange."*

"Mine was black and gray," Jorge says.

Jose Juan and Jorge's parents, Octavio and Angelica, found out about City Kids when Pastor Fernando, Hispanic Ministry Manager, handed them a flyer and his business card at a Vacation Bible School outreach in 2019. Knowing there was a way for their children to get the supplies they needed for school took an immense burden off of them – and it still does.

Now the Need is Even Greater

"It's a lot of help for us," Octavio says. *"Especially now, because of the pandemic. California is already expensive. It's tough because you have to pay your rent. You have to pay for your food. So it's so hard to get backpacks and the school supplies."*

"Thank you so much. Thank you for the support for our kids and for the children in the community. We are so happy when we see our kids have the backpacks and school supplies they need. They get so excited!" – Octavio

Octavio works in a local vineyard pruning and trimming grapevines. The work is enough to afford rent, food and a few other basic necessities.

"If we don't get school supplies from the Mission, it's going to be hard for us," Octavio explains. "They pay us every week so we can't afford to get all the supplies at once."

But City Kids is about more than backpacks and supplies. It's about helping kids fit in and succeed, making sure families have what they need and most importantly, sharing the love of Jesus.

"It's not only school supplies. It's clothes and shoes, so they can have all the supplies in order to go to school," Octavio says.

Each \$24.86 you give provides one backpack full of school supplies for one poor and needy student.

The Biggest Blessing of All: A Place in God's Family

Connecting with City Kids and Pastor Fernando through outreach ministries paved the way for Octavio and Angelica to attend church and begin relationships with Jesus! At the time, the family was really struggling, especially Octavio. Then he remembered the flyer and business card he'd been given at the park.

"I didn't know what to do. I was totally depressed. Then looked at the business card and the pamphlet, and then I called pastor and he told my wife and I about Jesus. I'm feeling strong in my faith. I feel very happy when I go to church."

Great things are ahead for this family, and with the help of friends like you, they'll have just what they need to succeed in school again this year!

Candy had no idea that when she felt called to serve the disadvantaged in her community, it would lead to a partnership with the Mission that has touched hundreds, if not thousands, of lives.

"I took City Kids to our church because I was looking for ways to get our church more involved in what the Mission was doing," she says.

Today, over half of the people who attend Redeemer Presbyterian help with City Kids – either by helping to prepare in advance or by volunteering at the event.

"We have a place for everybody to serve, if you want to serve on that day. And everybody looks forward to it," Candy says. "It's really given us something that the whole church can serve in at one time."

And the impact hasn't been limited to just City Kids.

"It unites your church together. As churches, as individual believers, we need to be able to touch our own community. And it's not that we don't have ways of touching people in our regular lives, but I don't think it's a good idea to isolate ourselves from people that we don't normally rub shoulders with. And what happened when we started doing City Kids, is that it expanded to other things."

Candy and most of the members of Redeemer Presbyterian plan to join us in-person again this year. We hope you will too!



Candy first got her church, Redeemer Presbyterian, involved in City Kids 16 years ago. Now, every year, over half of the church participates by planning and putting together booths, donating backpacks, serving at the event and more.
